#### THE FLORAL CITY LIBRARY

The first Floral City Library was built in 1959 by the Floral City Lions' Club on land donated by Mrs.Helen Anderson. This library, on U.S.Highway #41 south of Floral City, was provided with books donated by the Lions' Club and the Floral Garden Club. The Floral Garden Club landscaped and maintained the grounds and continued doing so until the new library was built. Garden Club members visited the schools in the Floral City area and drove pupils to the library to obtain books.

The present library was dedicated May 30,1969. It was built on land owned by Citrus County adjacent to the Floral City Community Building on Orange Avenue.

The library, formerly under the Central Region Library System is now part of the Citrus County Library System. The Floral City Library now acquires books through the county library system and from donations. At present, the total number of gardening books in the Floral City library stands at 155. The library uses a card catalog, listing books by title, author, and subject. Cards for large print books are filed separately. Books are classified according to the Dewey Decimal System or the Marc 4 System by the Technical Services Department of the Citrus County System.

Books and magazines may be borrowed for a two-week period from the Floral City Library or from any of the six libraries within the Citrus County Library System. Books may also be obtained from anywhere in the United States through the Florida State Library. The library offers frequent plant clinics featuring such subjects as lawn care, landscaping, and gardening in Florida. These clinics are sponsored by the Citrus County Extension Service and are well attended by both Floral City residents and other persons living in Citrus County.

At the Floral City Library gardening books of all types are in the highest-use category. Patrons are also drawn to the library by the monthly flower and foliage arrangements furnished by the Floral Garden Club. These arrangements are coordinated to the seasons and/or holidays. A recent arrangement was made to coordinate with an upcoming program on "African Memories." When it was temporarily removed for a few hours for display at the Garden Club meeting, the librarian was deluged with queries concerning its disappearance.
