Meals


Household chores

Road"]. It is the only all-girls therapeutic wilderness facility operated by EYA and is also a license substance abuse treatment center and where these girls learn the skills required to build effective relations, take responsibility for their choices and understand the consequences of their behavior. It was established in 1969 and is located on 860 acres in Floral City. The camp houses 60 girls and there is 49 staff members who share the responsibilities helping these young ladies reach their goals and get a second chance at life. They want to build a pool and need financial help doing it. The brochure offers gift opportunities outlined below:
