Brierwood and Fern Pts.  
Garden 5. 6630 S. Merleing Loop At the light, head east to Left (north) on Baker Street. Go < 1 mile to Right on Whalen to Left on Aloysia to Devil's Neck to Merleing Loop.  
Garden 6. 7279 Eastlake Drive You will pass Eastlake Dr. on your way to Merleing Loop. If you don't plan to purchase plants there, you may reverse the order of Gardens 5 & 6.

**Garden 1** - 9945 S. Florida Avenue (US 41) - Home of Elmer and Sue Wagner  
Located on five lush acres, you will see why this garden won "Best Landscape Design" from the Floral City Garden Club for 2007-08. Perfect in everyway and lovely to look at. Wagon wheels, antiques and a vintage bicycle enhance the gardens and favorites such as "Knock-out Roses" will delight you.

**Garden 2** - 12116 S. Briarwood Point (Oak Forest) - Home of Ray and Willa Heronema - There is nothing like walking through well-maintained flower beds to see the different seasonal plants that attract butterflies and hummingbirds. Ongoing changes are made in these gardens to create homes and food for the birds and other wildlife.

**Garden 3**-12098 S. Briarwood Point (Oak Forest) - Home of Steve and Judy Lane  
This tidy garden offers a wide range of plants, flowers and trees, most of which have colorful flowers or beautiful foliage. The butterflies and hummingbirds love it! Several citrus varieties are included as well as a huge vegetable garden. Be sure to take time to smell the roses!

**Garden 4** - 12480 Fern Point (Oak Forest) - Home of Carol Hart  
Overlooking a beautiful view of 40 acres, this one acre treed-property is a two time winner of the "Conservascape Garden" award from the Floral City Garden Club. The grounds are rustic with accent rocks in the individual gardens. Enjoy your walk and the view! *Refreshments will be served at this garden.*

**Garden 5** - 6630 S. Merleing Loop - Home of Bill and Betty Bishop  
This quaint lakeside cottage garden is set on the banks of the Floral City pool of Lake Tsala Apopka. There's always something in bloom here - tropical plants as well as Florida native plants. Lots of different wildlife including many species of birds and butterflies enjoy this habitat.

**Garden 6** - 7279 Eastlake Drive - Home of Hazel Stype  
Almost five acres of gentle rolling land take you to a truly secret place. Meander along stone walkways and see many flowering trees such as Frangipangi, Cassia and magnolias. The garden leads to a green lagoon and also has its own spring behind the house. *Flowering plants from Connie's Nursery, as well as from Floral City Garden Club members, will be available for purchase at this garden.*
